



## Hoss's to build new restaurant in Chambersburg

CHAMBERSBURG - Hoss's Steak & Sea House is moving its Chambersburg restaurant to a new location.

The new building will open next to the Day's Inn hotel at the site of the former Shoney's Restaurant, which closed in November of 1998.

Hoss's currently operates a restaurant near Walmart at 1740 Lincoln Way East, Chambersburg, which opened in 1984.

A real estate website lists an out-parcel space at that location as available for lease.

Brechbill & Helman Construction Co. Inc. of Chambersburg has been awarded the \$1.1 million contract to build the new restaurant, which will be located at 30 Falling Spring Rd.

The 7,700-square-foot restaurant will have a seating capacity of 250.

The architect is Kasun Architects, Inc. of Hollidaysburg and the site engineer is Martin and Martin of Chambersburg.

Brechbill & Helman Construction said work is scheduled to start within the next couple of weeks. Construction is scheduled to be completed in June 2012.

A spokesperson for Blair County-based Hoss's could not be immediately reached.
